Welcome to the Q4 retail catalogue from Softwood Books!

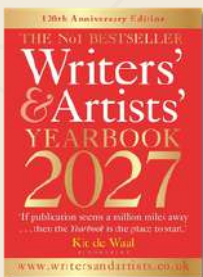
This edition has been published for the Gardners Trade Show, which we are proud to be sponsoring in 2026.

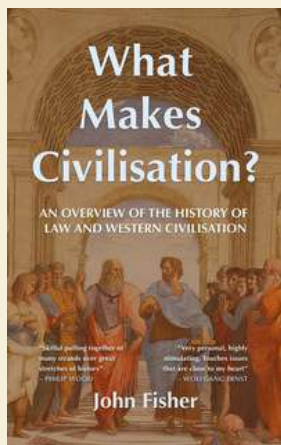
In the 1920s, electricity companies spent millions introducing the Grid as Britain's new domestic servant – a quiet helper waiting inside the wall – ready to boil the kettle and warm the hearth, all for a few pennies.
